

**MOM, DAD:** This week we and Project Homeword ask your families help in giving handcolored scriptures to people **outside** your home. Following are ideas for each day of the week, ideas that will make your children feel like they matter. No one can do them all but perhaps you could choose just one. **Monday...**is for relatives and friends. Ask your children who their favorite people are and color a scripture for them. Scripture is a great way to say thank you.

**Tuesday...**is for the sick. Ask your pastor if he knows of anyone who is having health problems. Scripture is a great way to say “Get Well”.

**Wednesday...**is for the new people in your church or people who live alone. Scripture is a great way just to say “Hi There”.

**Thursday...**is for people who work. Do you know anyone who has an office bulletin board. Scripture can make the whole week go better.

**Friday...**is for missionaries. They might use them with their own children or they might translate the scripture to another language and paste it over the English words. Ask your pastor if he knows of a missionary who might use some free coloring pages and send them some.

**Saturday...**is for community. Make 20-50 copies of one or more coloring pages and put them in a shallow box with a pack of crayons. Ask God to lead you to a Doctor, Auto Repair Shop or Insurance Agent who might let you leave them in his waiting room. Put your church address and phone number on the back of each page.

**Sunday** is for rest.
